
This garment is an undergarment designed to be worn under denim pants.

This garment is fitted with impact protectors for the knees and hips. There are no vents to allow airflow movement through the garment.

The abrasion test results above were conducted under a 10 ounce denim. Protection levels may be lower if this garment was worn under different pant materials. The garment scored 6/10 (4.87) for abrasion and three stars (44.0) for protection when tested as a stand-alone garment.

#### **Abrasion Resistance**

These pants were tested for abrasion resistance in accordance with MotoCAP test protocols. The diagram below is a visual indication of the likely abrasion performance of the materials in each zone calculated from the data in the table below.
